Neutronics Developing the Next Generation of Identifiers.

Neutronics is in the midst of development of a new refrigerant identifier targeting the Recleaim industry. This new Identifier will feature greatly enhanced detection of 400 series refrigerants and include component breakdown. As an Example for R410a the unit will say 50% R32 and 50% R125.

If the refrigerant was mixed it might display 90% R22, 5% R32 and 5% R125. This would let the technician know he was dealing with R22 and R410a. Other refrigerants on the list include R404a, R407C, R408A, R409 and as many as 20 more. The Super Ultima is scheduled for completion at the end of 2009 and should be available by the end of January 2010.

Although it will not replace a GC, it will certainly be as close as any identifier has ever come. Come see for yourself at the 2010 AHR Expo in Orlando.

New Mini ID R22 Identifier Gives HVAC Service Tech's an Advantage

The transition away from R22 refrigerant in the HVAC market has given rise to numerous R22 replacement refrigerants. While R410a dominates the market in new systems, it is not generally suitable to replace R22 in existing installations. This is where the R22 replacements come in. Unlike automotive systems, HVAC applications use the same fitting regardless of the refrigerant contained inside leading to a risk that the refrigerant inside the unit is not what's on the label. Did you know that mixing a little as 1 lb. of the wrong refrigerant with R22 in a 50 lb. recovery cylinder can make the refrigerant too contaminated to be reused? With current disposal rates for bad R22 running \$4 per lb. and current credit for good used R22 running up to \$2 per lb., just one contaminated 50 lb. recovery tank could cost you \$300!

The mini ID R22 quickly and easily confirms that the refrigerant in the system is R22 greatly reducing the risk of recovering the wrong refrigerant into your R22 cylinder. The Mini ID R22 will begin shipping the first week of February and all the details can be found on RefrigerantID.net .
